

SAUVIGNON BLANC

IGT Terre Siciliane

The Sauvignon Blanc is the white wine from the Celso Pesce Estate in Salemi, wanted by the family to enrich with new expressions the collection of wines produced at the Baglio Donnafranca winery.



GRAPES: Sauvignon Blanc (100%)

DENOMINATION: IGT Terre Siciliane

WINE-GROWING AREA: Celso Pesce Estate - Salemi - Sicilia

VINEYARDS: di Celso Pesce

SOILS: hilly orography, Marly calcareous soil with the presence of small slabs of golden yellow limestone.

PLANTING YEAR: 2009

ALTITUDE: 380 m a.s.l.

VINEYARD EXPOSURE: North - South

DENSITY OF VINES PER HECTARE: 4000 (sesto 250×100)

TRAINING SYSTEM: espalier

TYPE OF PRUNING: short Guyot

YIELD OF GRAPES PER HECTARE: About 70 quintals

HARVEST PERIOD: second week of August

TYPE OF HARVEST: manual in 15 kg boxes

VINIFICATION: soft pressing of whole grapes, static clarification of must

FERMENTATION: in stainless steel at a temperature of 14-18° C

MALOLACTIC FERMENTATION: not carried out

AGING: in steel tanks in contact with the yeasts for 6 months and a further 3 months in the bottle

BOTTLING: cold in a controlled atmosphere

TYPE OF BOTTLE: 75 cl

TYPE OF CORK: technical cork microgranin

ALCOHOL CONTENT: 12% Vol.
